### **NEW BUSINESS :**

### **ROCHESTER NUMISMATIC ASSOCIATION'S 25TH ANNUAL COIN SHOW:**

The Rochester Numismatic Association was founded in 1912 so the members could plan a coin show and convention of the A.N.A. the following year for Rochester, NY. About every ten years thereafter the club would sponsor a coin show with the dealers coming from throughout the country. B. Max Mehl was in Rochester enough to apply for membership in the club. But it was in 1972 that the R.N.A. decided to turn its coin show into an annual event.

To celebrate the 25th anniversary show to be held October 18th and 19th 1997 the R.N.A. has issued an 1 1/2 inch proof like medal in bronze and in fine silver ( one oz.)

The medal's obverse shows the famous John James Audubon portrait of Nathaniel Rochester. The medal was designed and engraved by Thomas Rodgers who currently is serving as a coin die engraver at the Philadelphia Mint.

The medals are struck in very limited number by the North American Mint in Rochester, NY. Only 50 bronze and 13 silver copies are available.

Silver medals are \$15.00, and Bronze pieces are priced at \$ 7.50. Postage and insurance is \$2.00. Address orders to Rochester
